

### **Checklist of things to bring to camp:**

Check the items on the list which you are bringing to camp and tape this list to the inside of your suitcase. Please write your name clearly on each item.

Please do not bring new or expensive items to camp. Please do not bring any knives, leatherman or any weapons. Electronic devices of any kind, including but not limited to MP3 players, cell phones, game systems, laptops, pagers, etc are now **PROHIBITED**.

**Campers are allowed to bring stand alone digital cameras.**

**Camp cannot be responsible for any items that are lost, damaged or left at camp.**

- Balance of camp fee. Payable with cash or check only.
- Money for camp store (No more than \$10 per week.) No money in cabins. We hold the money for the campers and change is given out at sign-out.
- Health Form-Do not mail ahead.
- \*\*Prescriptions\*\*** Must be in original container! Attachment C of the Health Form **MUST** be filled out and signed by the physician. All medications are kept in the Nurses' Cabin, unless approved by the health care staff.
- Camp T-shirts (Will be sold during Registration on Sunday, if you purchase one, we recommend you put your name on it immediately.)
- Personal hygiene items: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, sunscreen, bug spray, deodorant, hairbrush/comb etc. (Please **NO** aerosol cans).
- Warm sleeping bag or 2 blankets & sheets (If your child is a bed wetter, please double this.)
- Twin fitted sheet to cover the mattress
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Plastic bag for wet items
- Laundry bag
- Bathing suit & large pool towel
- Bath towels & wash clothes
- Raincoat...a must!
- 2 pairs of sneakers or shoes
- Boots (hiking and/or mud)
- Pants/Jeans (at least 3 pairs)
- Shorts
- Shirts (both long & short sleeves)
- Socks (extra, lots!!)
- Undergarments
- Pen/pencil & writing paper
- Self addressed & stamped envelopes
- Flashlight
- Water Bottle
- Stuffed animal
